These six children possessed special talents, carrying the spirit of their cities and listening to the whispers of the earth



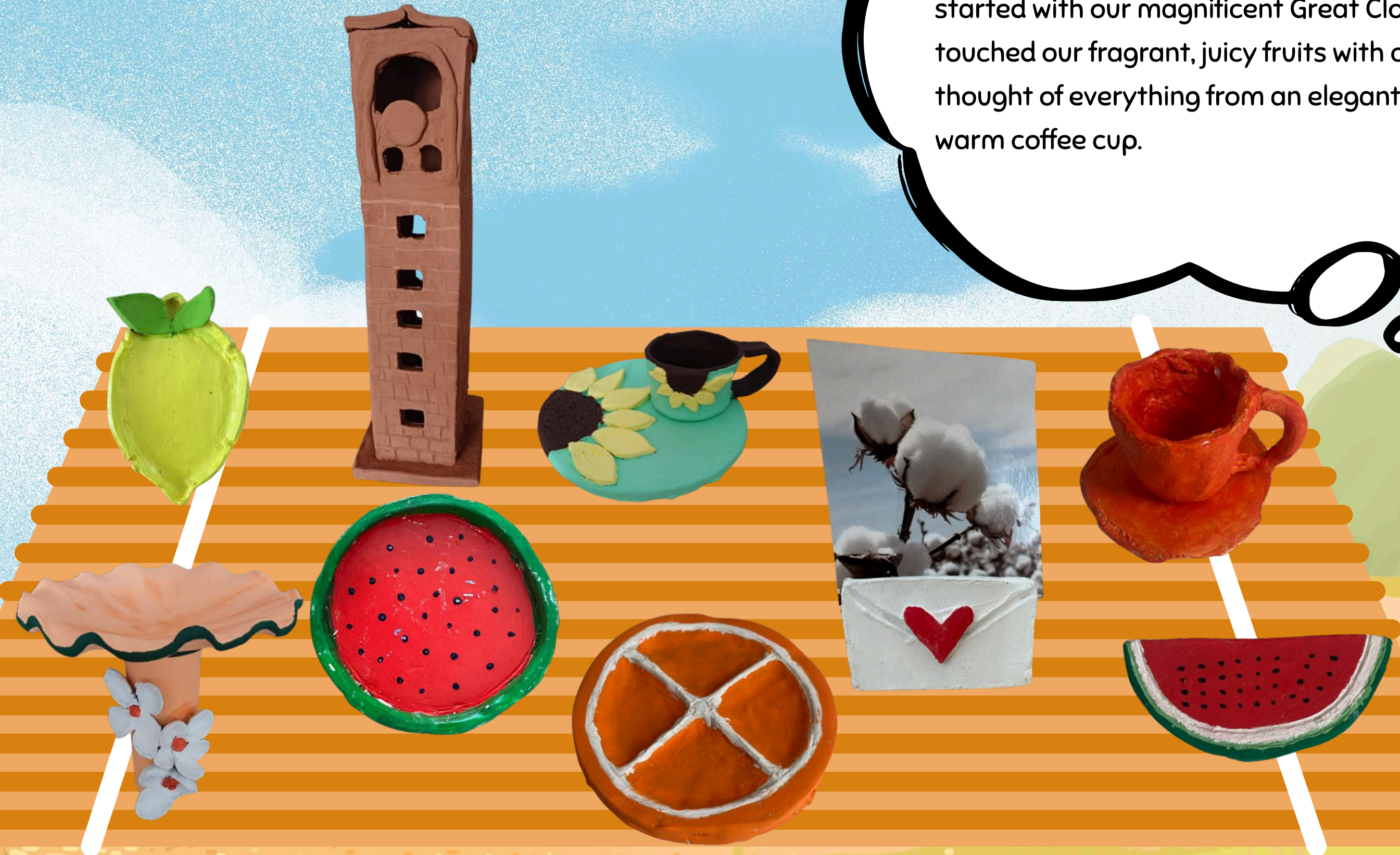


One day, these seven children met through a distant email. Each shared photos and stories of the clay objects they had created with their own hands

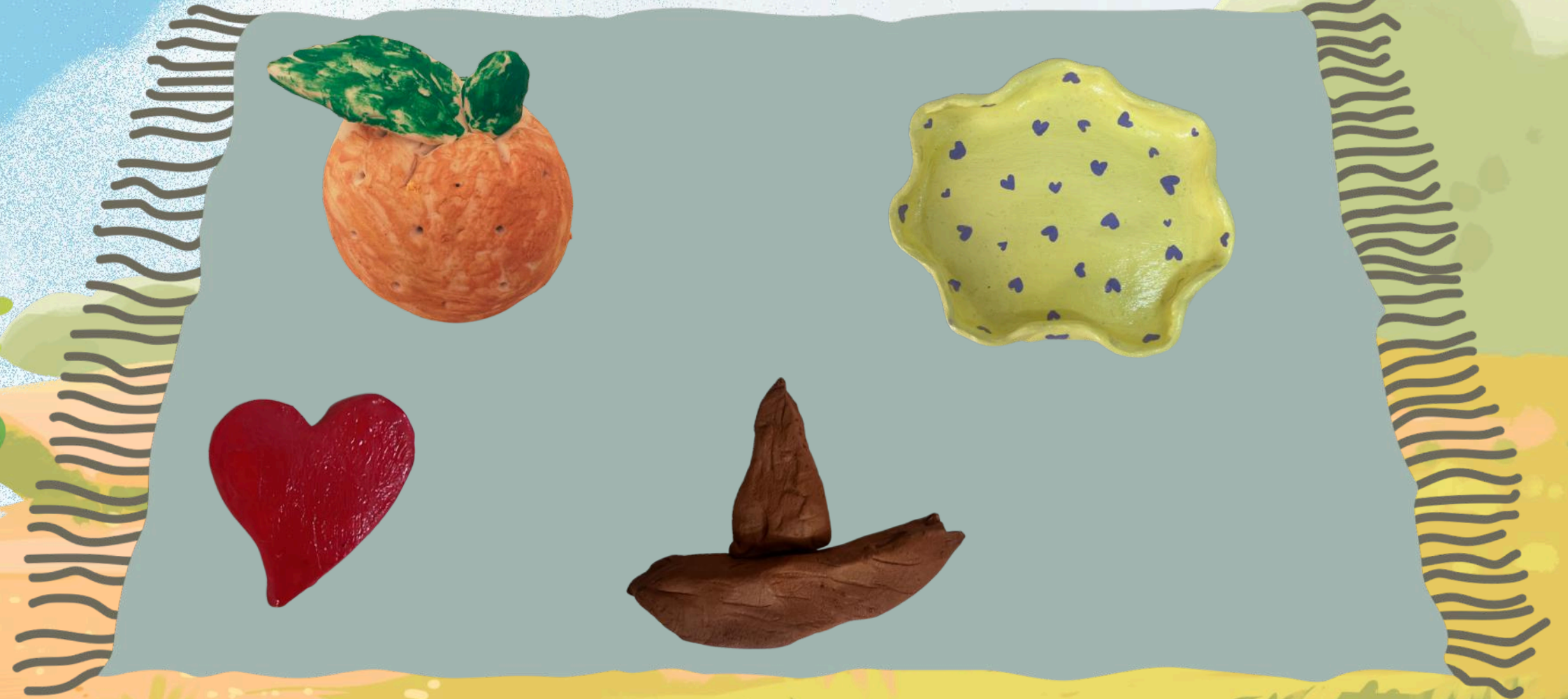
Ela designed many figures unique to İzmir. Now, let's hear from Ela.

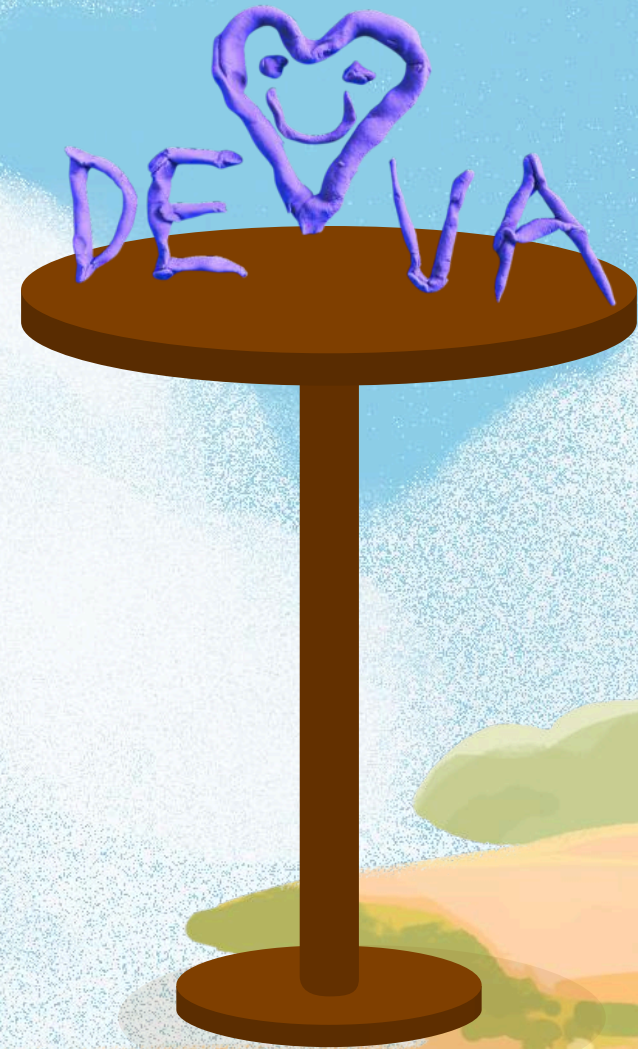
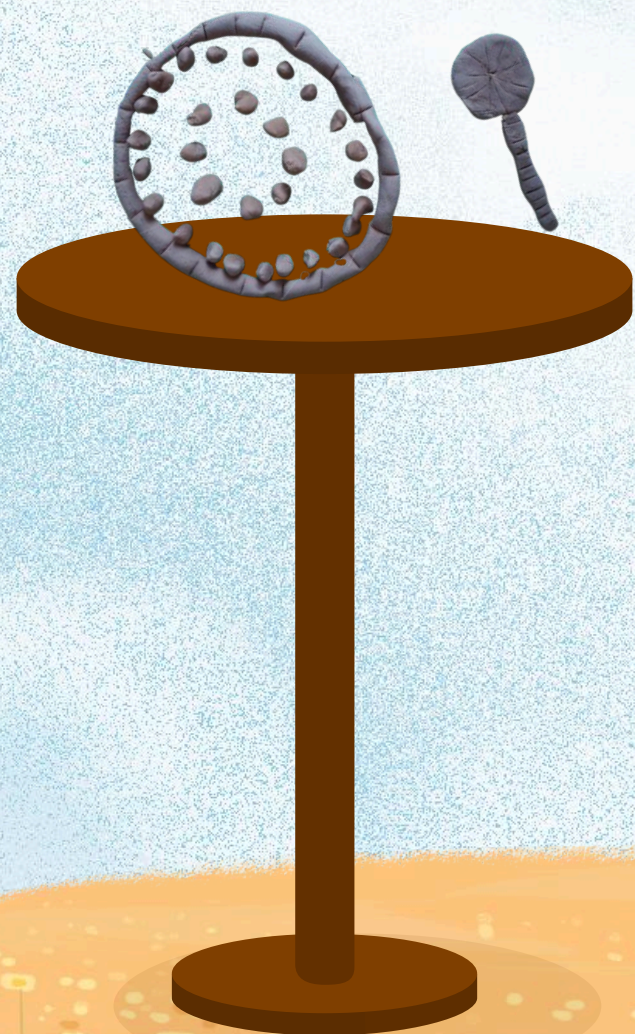
Seval describes her unique designs from Muğla.

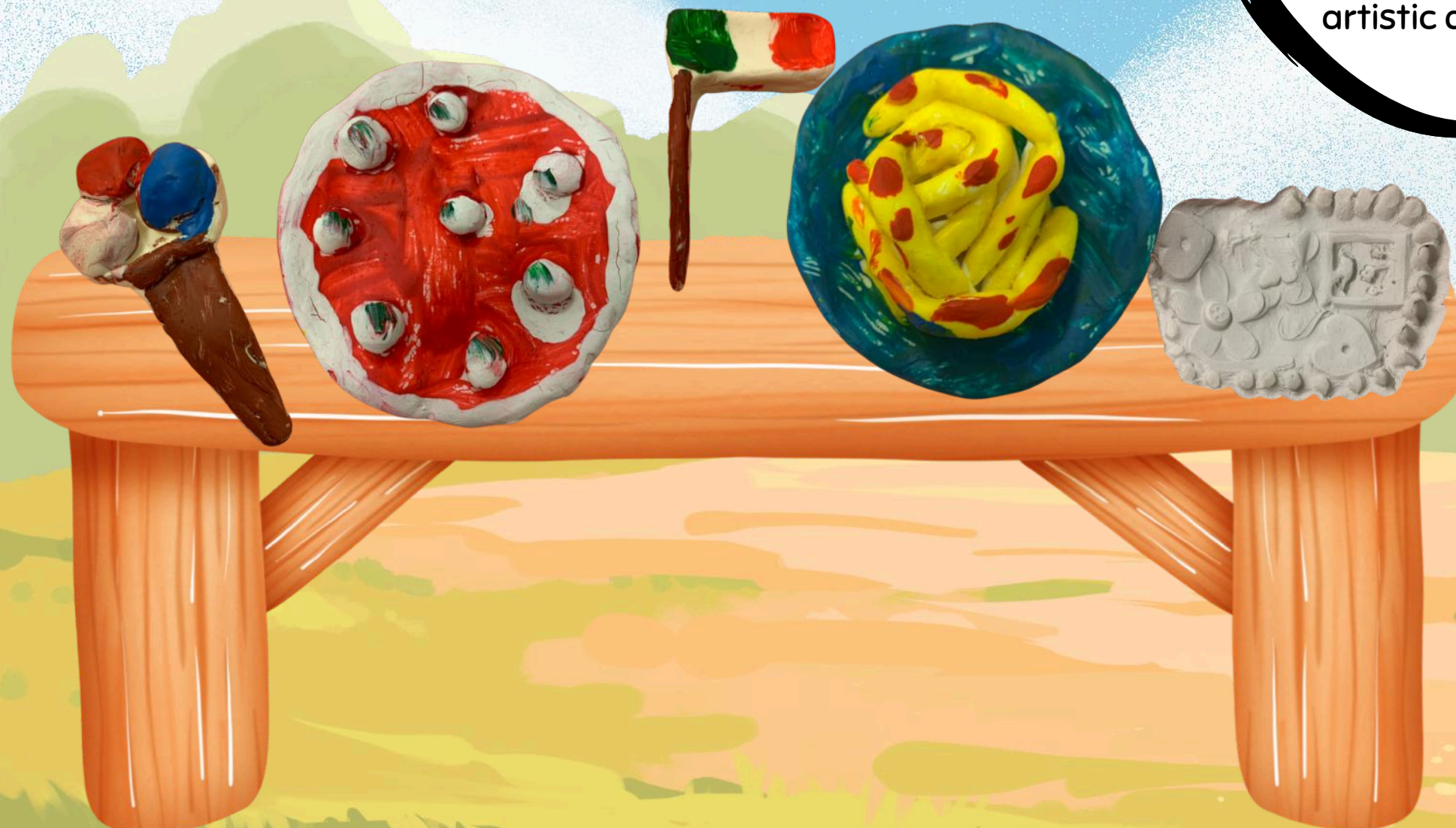
Dava presents to you Deva's most beautiful designs.

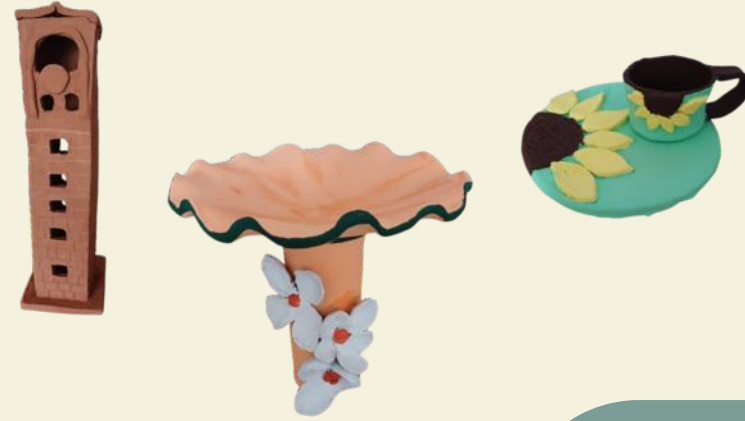

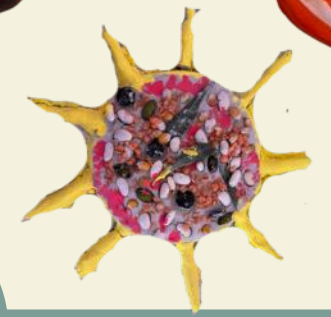

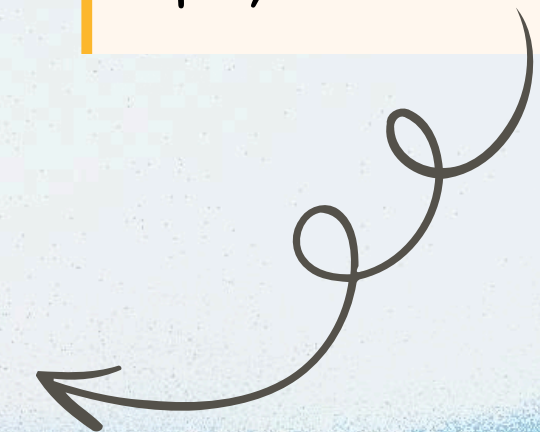
